Network Summary

My task is that of working with approximately one hundred plus churches and seventeen language groups in the Denver metro association of Southern Baptists, as the Urban Church Planter Strategist and the Ethnic/Language Coordinator.

My primary assignment is to see new congregations started within the inner and central city and among the multiplicity of ethnic/language groups that populate our area of influence and to help facilitate in initiating a church planting movement in these contexts.

Values and Activities

- That all church planting activities must be indigenous in nature - no matter what the context.
- That all church planting activities must be contextual.
- That all ministry/missions activities must have as their goals: evangelism, congregationalizing, leadership development, spiritual transformation, multiplication and community.
- That all believers/church planters should become experts at culture.
- That outside (out of context) funding will result in mediocrity in church planting activities and that outside funding will absolutely kill a church planting movement.
- That for the lostness that surrounds us to be penetrated, we must think small and simple.
- That we have been asking the wrong question. Not how many churches can we start, but rather what would it take for every person, in our area of influence (city, neighborhood, work place, apartment complex, etc.) to hear the gospel, have an opportunity to respond, be disciplined, and worship the most high God. Then a CPM could begin.
