Name That Tune

• A great group game filled with lots of opportunity to carry this over from week to week. Using various genres of music from different time periods helps involve many people from different ages. A memorable game with lots of laughter and singing.

Hot Seat

- Each week bring up a core team couple for an interview session in front of the whole core team. Let the couple you choose be a surprise to them and to the group. Interview each spouse with fun questions about their marriage and personal life. Have a special "rapid-fire" round with quick questions with quick answers. Suggested questions include:
 - What is your spouse's favorite food?
 - What is your most embarrassing story?
 - What is something your spouse does that you love?
 - How did you all meet?
 - How did you meet Jesus?
 - If there is one place your spouse could visit, where would it be?

Name that Staff Member or Core Team Member

• Collect old photographs (baby pictures, pics from early days in sports or high school, etc) of either staff members or core team members to put in a Keynote or PowerPoint presentation. Have the core team guess who is who from their old photographs.

Who Did What, Way Back When

• Collect one line stories from however many people you would like to put in a document. These can be outrageous or embarrassing stories from your core team members or staff members. Hand out the document and have the core team guess who did what, way back when. A sentence can be something like, "Dressed up as an elephant for a high school musical" or "Tripped over a curb and fell down while on a date."
