EXERCISE

- What does “the rebellion against the rebellion” look like in your context?

Go back to the list you brainstormed from Session 1 and do a check-in with your team.

- How is prioritizing the least of these going? How are you engaging the marginalized in your community?

Create a 9x9 grid. Put an “X” in the middle of the grid representing your home or the location your core team is meeting. Then begin to work around the rest of the grid like it’s a map. To the left of the middle box think east, to the box above the middle box think north.

- In those boxes write down the people groups you see in that section of the city. How do you see them rebelling against the Father’s rule and reign? (Example: To the south, local college, idol is knowledge and independence)
- How will your plant speak into that area of your city? How will you rebel against the rebellion?

Work through several of the boxes. Praying as your work to get a sense of where you need to start doing the work of the church in those areas.
